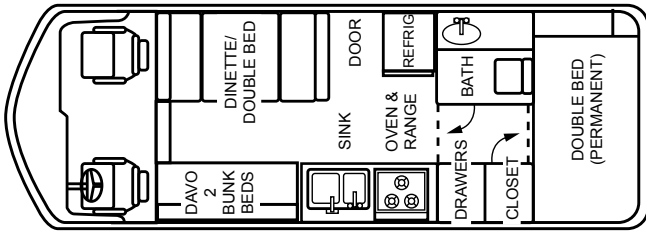

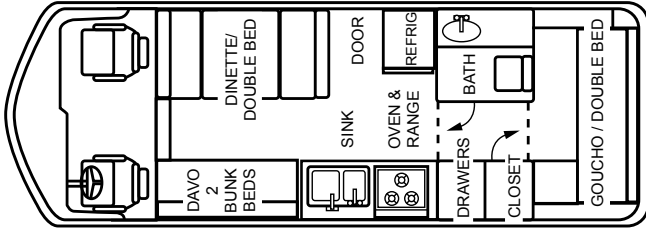

Coachmen, known as Jimmy Motorhomes, up-fitted the Birchaven and Royale models.

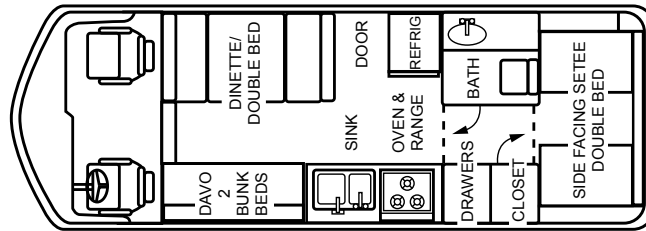

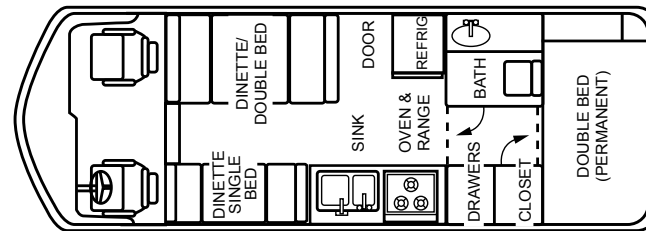
BASE FLOOR PLAN 26'-1



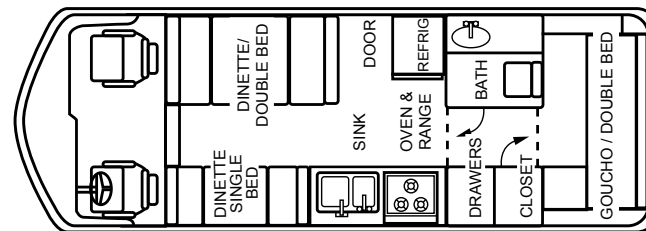
FLOOR PLAN 26'-2



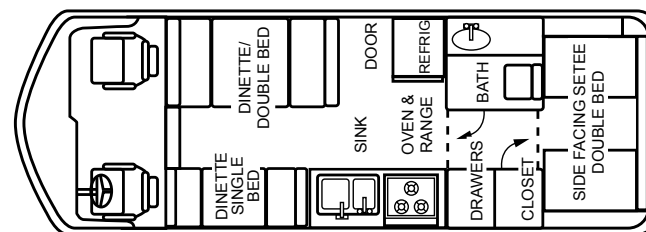
FLOOR PLAN 26'-3

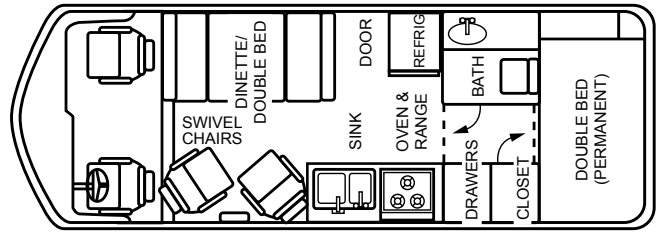


FLOOR PLAN 26'-5

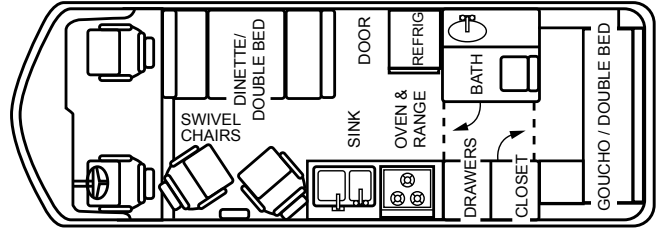


FLOOR PLAN 26'-6

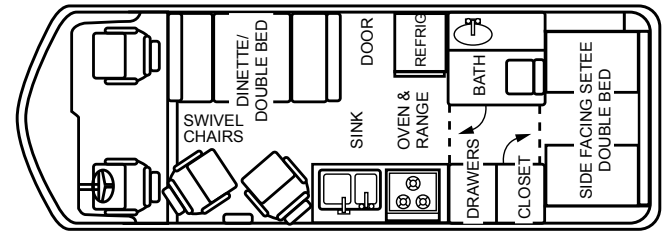

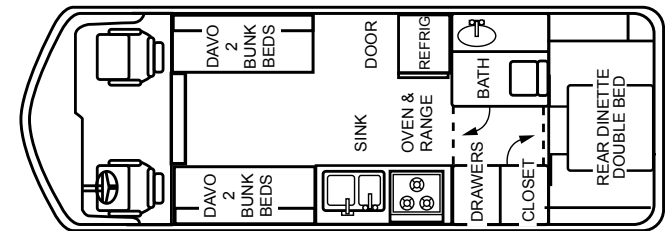
BASE FLOOR PLAN 26'-7



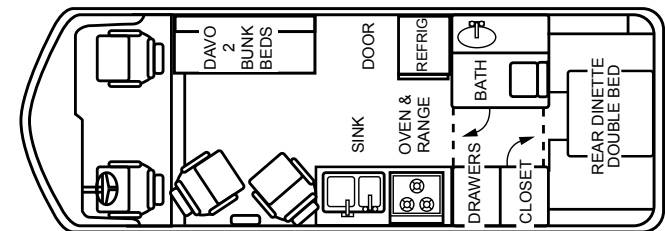
FLOOR PLAN 26'-8



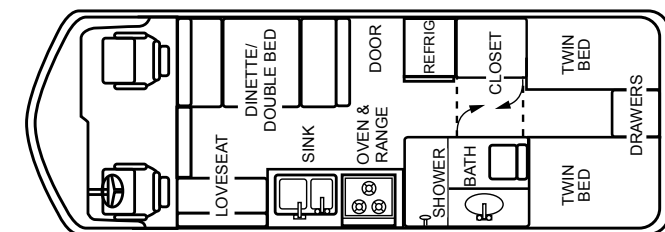
FLOOR PLAN 26'-9

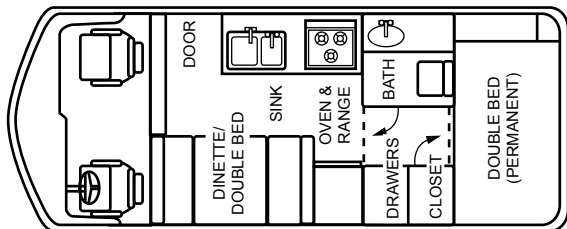


FLOOR PLAN 26'-11

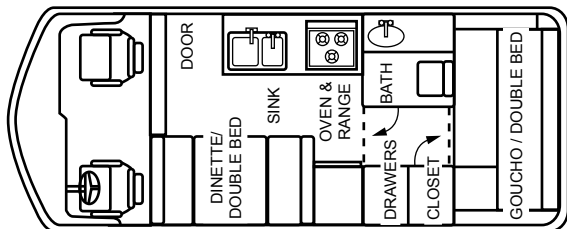


FLOOR PLAN REAR TWIN BED

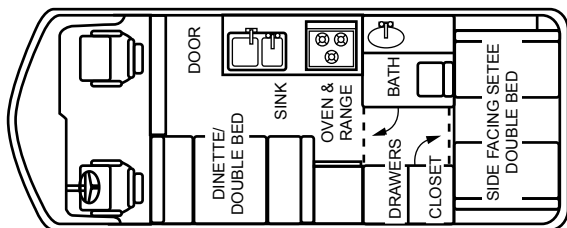

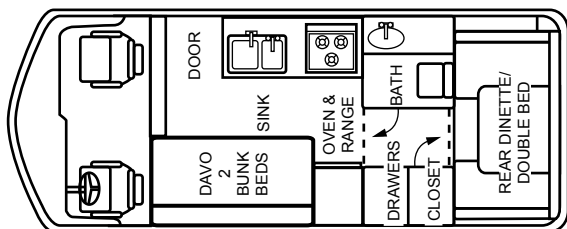
FLOOR PLAN 23'-1



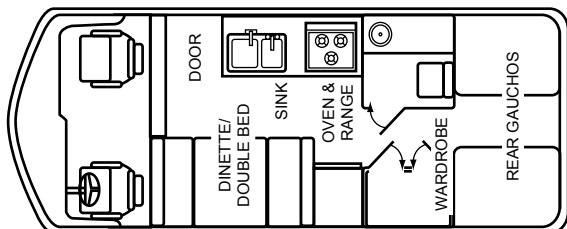
FLOOR PLAN 23'-2



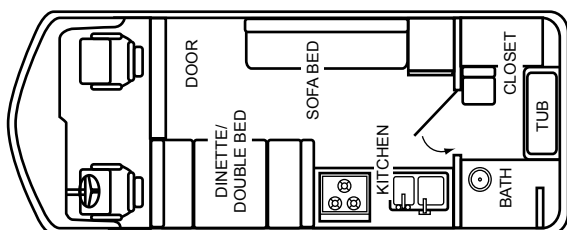
FLOOR PLAN 23'-3

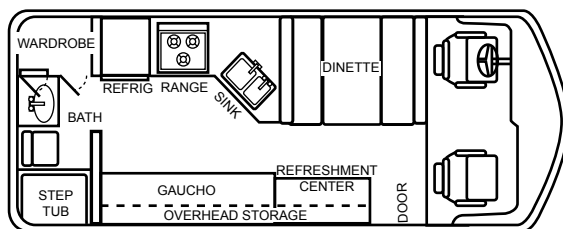


FLOOR PLAN 23'-5

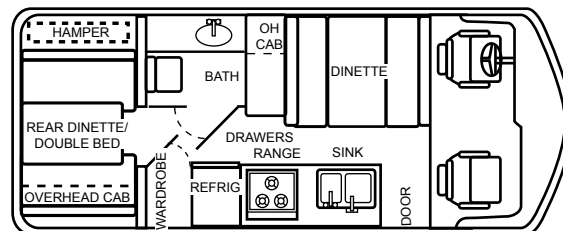

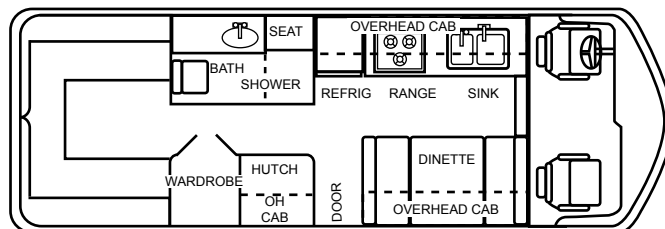


REAR BATH

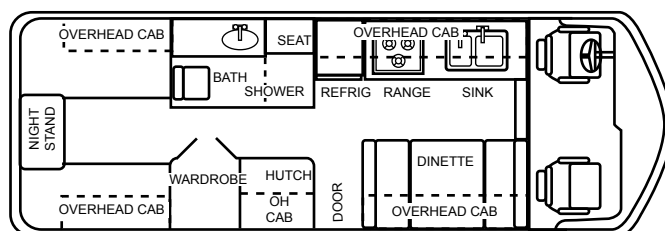

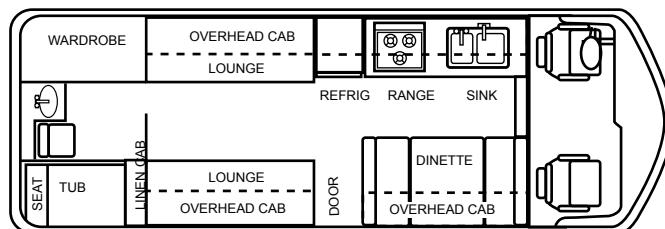

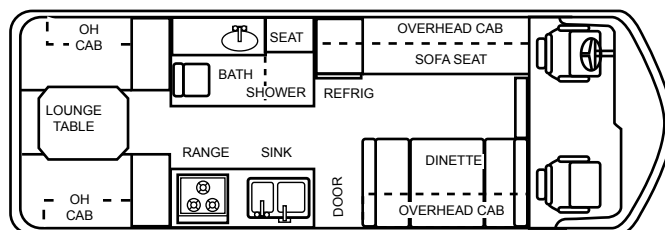
